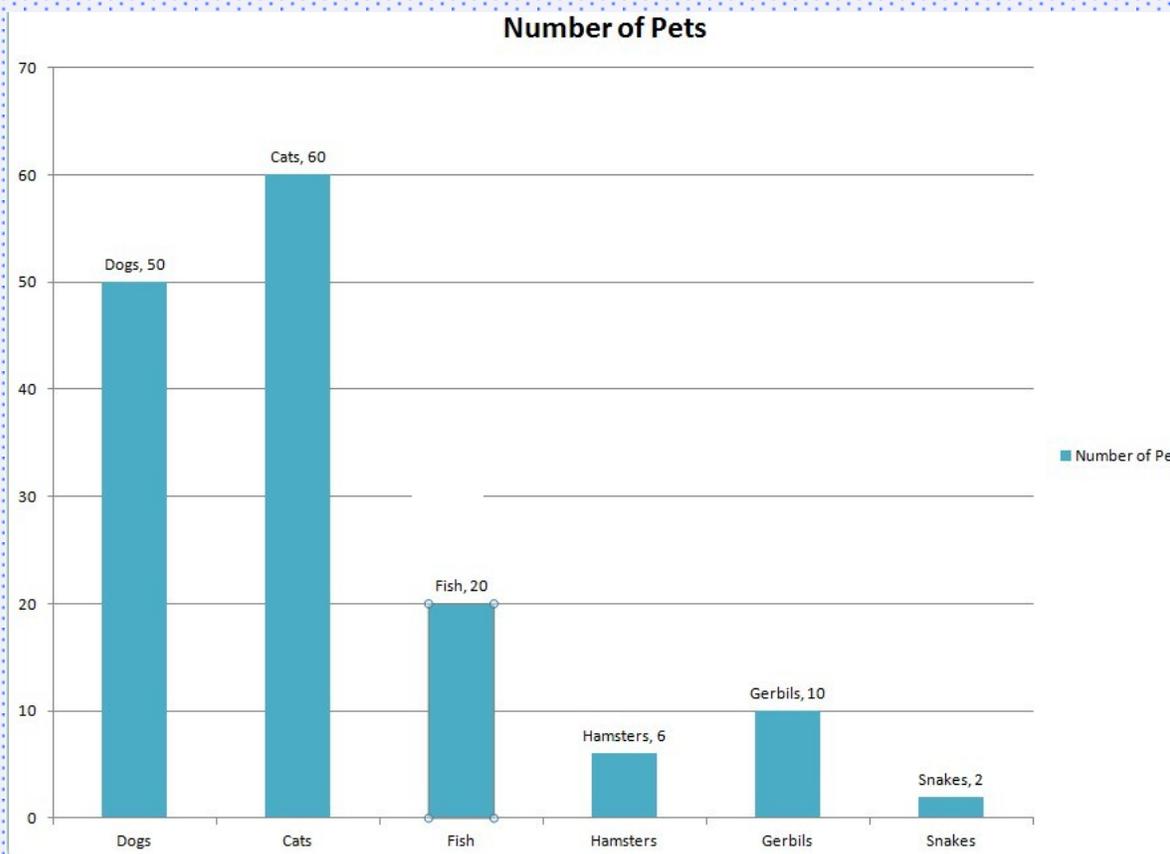

Bar Graph



Excel Lesson

Objectives: The students will input the data required for a graph.
The students will design a graph.
The students will personalize the graph using design elements.

Step 1

Using Excel, the students will open to Book 1 and the instructor will direct them to arrange the columns as follows:

1. Place the mouse between column A and B and the mouse will change to double headed.

2. Drag mouse to the col-width. When it is enough, following row 1:

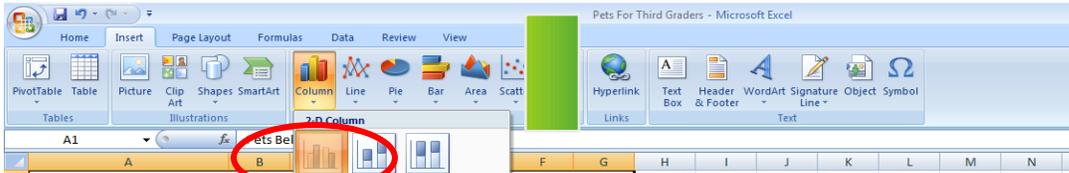
5. Then they type in the number of pets on row 2.

1. Dragging your mouse over the data, highlight all that will be included in your

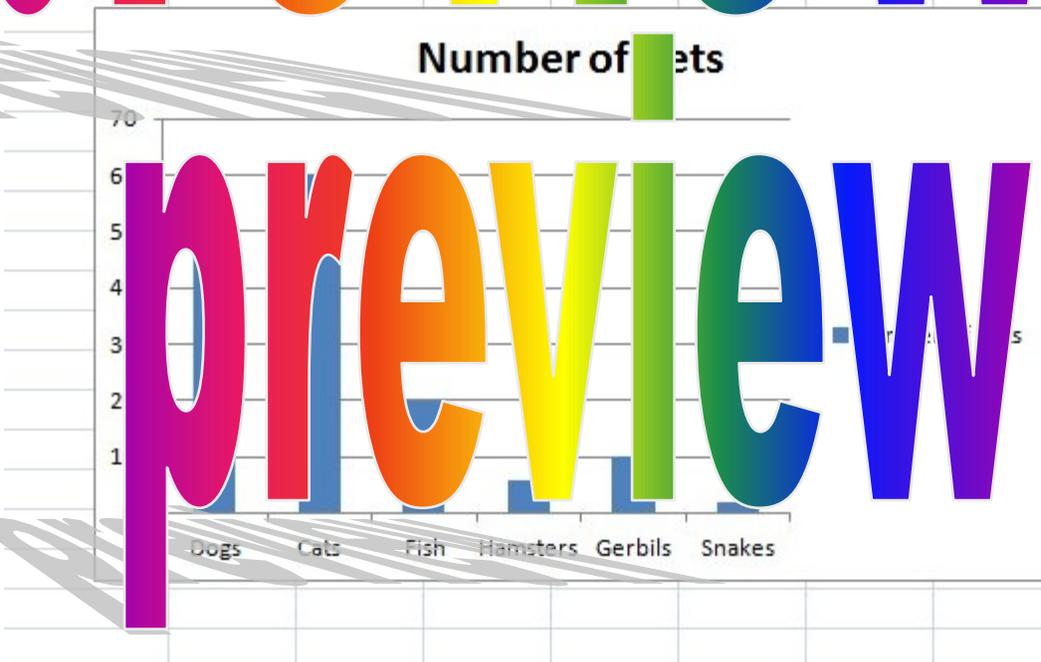

2. Click on "Insert" and choose "Column". Click on the first choice under 2-D Column.



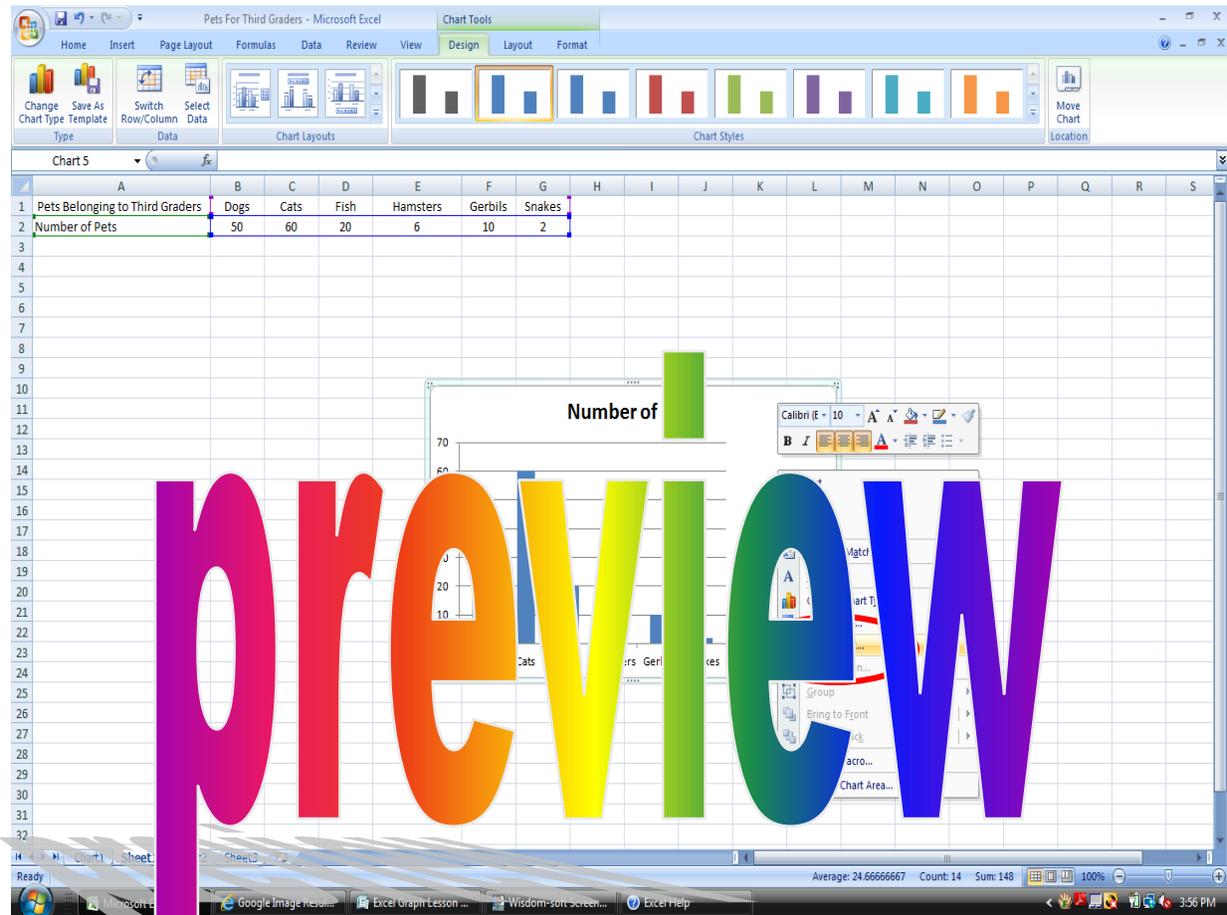

3. The first graph will appear



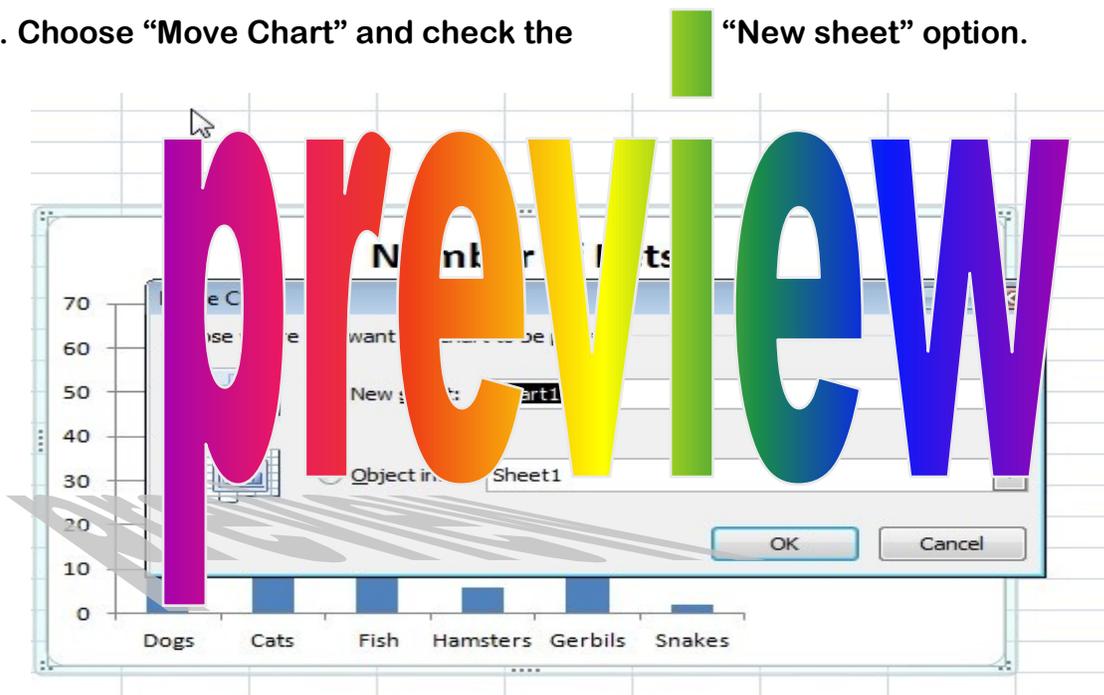
appear in the middle of the page.

5. Choose "Move Chart" and check the "New sheet" option.

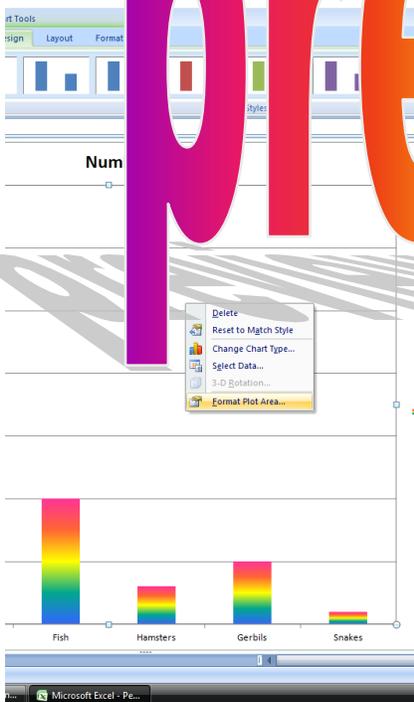

By placing the mouse on one of the bars and right clicking the student will get the choice to “Format Data Series”. Here they can change the fill, and experiment with shading and a variety of design elements.

Step 3

Number of Pets

This is where the student can make the graph their own using color or other design elements. The first and easy difference is located above the graph where the student can choose by clicking their mouse on the various colors.

Depending on the experience of your students, this may be a good place to end the lesson. However, they can individualize the design even more.
